


Travel as a team: Organising group adventures for patients

CKD in Denmark

- 1 out of 10 suffer from CKD
- Danish KPA has 6200 members
- Dialysis patient or transplanted
- Approximately 3000 Danes are on dialysis

How to travel as a Danish patient

- All treatments are for free; the public hospitals or holiday dialysis
- EHIC card
- Denmark divided into 5 regions with own regulations for refunding holiday treatments

-"we need the full pack"




Group travel in several steps

- Time for take-off




Why group travel is important for patients
